- (23) folk lore group - ^{small town in western} ~~CINCINNATI ROSEMARY BOLSTAD~~ (roughly translated) group title "On the other side of the Daugavaus River are Dark woods" 1989 (in Raina DVINA ^{between Latvia & Estonia}) The D. River flows thru Russia & Latvia into the bay of Riga.
- (24) "Things I Wonder" The Shaggs (off philosophy of the world) re-issue rounder records 1980 Betty, Helena Doff Wiggins are the Shaggs (heut sem the film)

(25) "Sunset people" Donna Summer 1948 (off of Badgirls 1977) Till a few weeks ago she was from Boston R.I.P. moved to NY in late 60's, was front singer for "The Crows"

(25) This Little Bird This is for Kelly Crow who first told me Donna she had died. Kelly was in a band called Push Carnival, ~~you can hear her~~ to hear them: check out ~~on~~ Band Camp / union furnace publishing I went to Union furnace w/ Mike Rep on one of our backwater Ohio adventures.

(26) "This Little Bird" Nancy Sinatra produced by Lee Hazlewood - words by John Loudermilk 1960's Japanese issue Dick & Jane please cover "Dark in My heart" I found this reprise single hitting Coral red w/ Nancy ~~is~~ dangerously orange ~~Japanex~~ characters w/ a yellow dress

(28) "You're Gonna Watch Me" Pussler-Morgen Charlotte Pussler was a close childhood friend. This single came out in 1977 on Pere Dbo's Lab-f. Heatheram Records. Charlotte was married to ~~the~~ the very late Peter
